Fingerstyle guitar tab for 'Bonaparte crossing the Rhine'. The piece is in standard tuning (E-A-D-G-B-E) and 4/4 time, with a tempo of 120 beats per minute. The tab is written for a six-string guitar and includes a variety of techniques such as single notes, double notes, triplets, and a final double circle (0-0) at the end.
